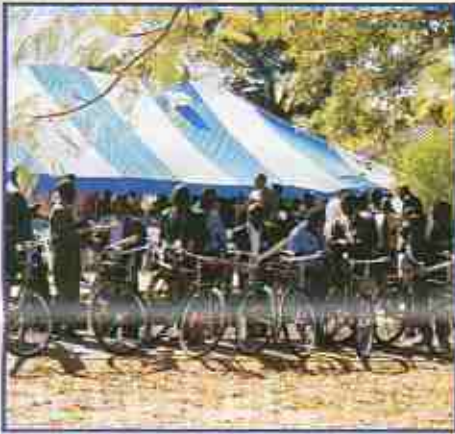

# From The United States of America



I PICKED UP the World Missions brochure and read. The pastors and evangelists in Africa needed bicycles. Their need for this simple, basic means of transportation, which would help them more effectively fulfill their call to spread the gospel, touched my heart in a deep and personal way. Instead of putting the brochure away after I finished reading, I kept it lying out as a reminder to pray for the ministers and their need. I knew God was speaking to me about this particular project, but I had no idea the way my involvement in it would unfold.

God continued to speak to my heart. Every time I went in to the Dollar Tree store, a cluster of little glass bicycles stared me in the face. Maybe I was slow to comprehend what God was telling me, or maybe what happened was exactly according to His plan and His timing. But this went on for about six months, until one day, as I walked through the store, those bicycles became giant-size in my vision and in my mind. On my drive home, I said, "OK, Lord, I know this is You." I later purchased the 20 little glass bicycles, and my two prayer partners and I prayed over them, and received His confirmation in our spirits that He was working with us in this project.

I had flyers prepared and enclosed them in our church bulletin on Easter Sunday morning. I explained that the cost for one bicycle for one pastor was \$100, and I asked the people to donate any amount toward bicycles for the African pastors and evangelists. I offered one of the little glass bicycles to anyone who donated \$20 or more. My goal was to collect enough money to buy four bicycles for four

African ministers. But God evidently had an entirely different goal in mind.

God had been speaking to the hearts of a young couple who attend our church, Ronnie and Yvette Pique. They had received a bonus check, which they decided not to deposit in their bank account. Instead, they decided to find a project where they could contribute the money, and they asked God to show them the project they should support.

When they got to church on Easter Sunday, Yvette saw the flyer in the bulletin, and she said, "This is it; this is our project."

Ronnie gave an envelope to my husband and said, "Pastor, give this to Sister Wilson for the bicycles project." He gave it to me and, like I usually do on Sundays when things are

handed to me, I stuck it in my church bag. After church, I observed that several people were donating money and taking little glass bicycles. I thought, *Well, my project is well on its way toward purchasing four bicycles.*

Back home, paper and pen in hand, I began recording the names of those who had purchased a glass bicycle, then started counting the money. I praised the Lord when I counted enough to purchase one bicycle. Then I remembered the envelope Dwight had given me before church started. I asked him to count its contents while I continued making my list of donations. My heart was happy when he said "One hundred dollars." I thought, *Praise the Lord, two bicycles. Now I am well on my way toward my goal of four bicycles.* But he didn't stop counting. "Two hundred, three hundred," he continued. My heart was pounding, and I was worshiping and praising God . . . and trying to catch my breath. The envelope held \$1,310. I had enough to buy 14 bicycles.

Over the next two weeks, God showed me how wonderfully He can provide—"exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think." What I thought would be enough for only four bicycles has turned out to be 20 bicycles and 20 Bibles for each of the 20 pastors and evangelists. All from listening to God's promptings to purchase 20 little glass bicycles.

Through this experience, God has shown me that whether it is for His missionaries around the world or for one of His own in a nearby place, He is Jehovah-Jireh—"The Lord doth provide." He wonderfully provides. ☺
