# ZIM PREACHERS DESPERATELY NEEDS BICYCLES

ZIMBABWE IS IN A DESPERATE SITUATION... It has been said: "We know the real answer is Jesus Christ who alone can change people's lives and circumstances. Our answer is not political, but the life changing gospel of Jesus Christ."

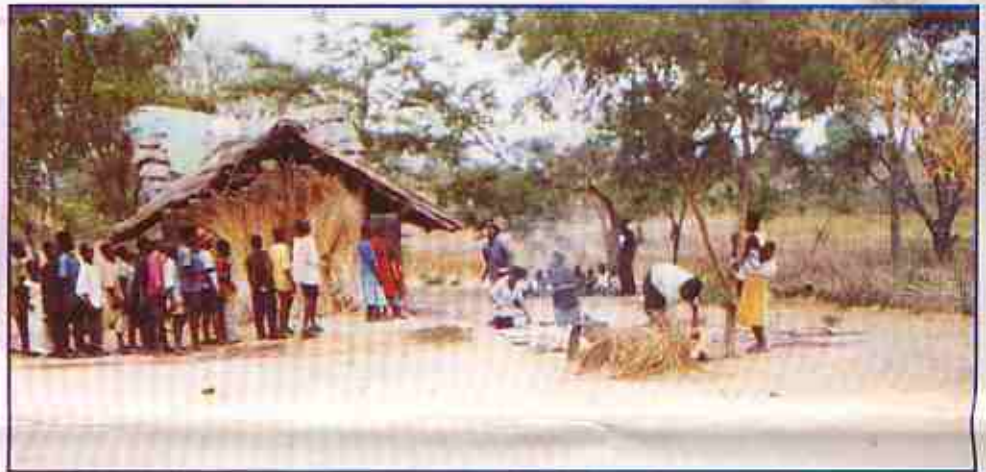
According to Pastor Jabha working for the Lord in Karoi in North Zimbabwe: "The need has never been so great as now as the Zim Dollar has gone down and prices have increased. Pastors cannot even afford to hire taxi's or busses. One loaf of bread currently costs 2000 Zim dollars (November 2003)."

The latest report from Pastor Dick Roberts, Missions Director of the Full Gospel Church of God in South Africa, touched my heart when he said that even the most fortunate of Pastors, previously in leadership positions in Zimbabwe, who had a car, now have to walk and travel by bicycle because of the monetary problem in Zimbabwe.

Pastor Sebengo from Harare confirmed to me two weeks ago that the need has never been so great for bicycles in Zimbabwe, for the servants of the Lord to do the work of ministry.

*Wheels for God's Word & Word on Wheels* are trusting the Lord once more for 60 (sixty) bicycles for our outreach in Zimbabwe during the last week of January 2004.

**Will you take up the challenge and invest in God's Kingdom to help these men who have given their lives to spread the gospel?**

# TESTIMONIES

## Many thanks for your donation of bicycles

Since our last letter we have had an exiting time. Pastor Danilel Mahoko and I went to Mozambique, where we ministered the Word of God in Chimoio, which is the capital in the province of Manica, and which has about 200 000 inhabitants. We also spent 2 days in Beira, which is the capital in the province of Sofala and also the second largest city in Mozambique. In Chimoio we ran seminars for 8 days, as it is here that Pastor Roy Manuel Meque, who I have known for the last 6 years, lives.

We were surprised to see that Pastor Meque and his people had built a church which is 13.7 m long and 6.5 m wide and can accomodate about 200 people. At this stage it has only a stamped clay floor, but the construction itself gave us much to think over. Perhaps we can do something similar in Delmore, RSA, with regard to the way the pillars and the roof supports were made. The roof itself was made of 34 sheets of corrugated iron for which we donated R2000.

### Gauteng Agape Ministries writes to Wheels

Pastor Meque had also built a small hut for us. It was made of clay without a floor, but with mats of straw and a roof of corrugated iron sheets. We were quite comfortable there, when our air mattresses had the right pressure and we crawled into our sleeping bags. Most importantly, there were no mosquitoes there!

We gave teaching on prayer; the church of God; the Holy Spirit; deliverance and also about evangelization. We also gave them 36 (thirty six) or six sets of six books from Sattelite Bible College International. God provided an English speaking teacher to interperate for us. He has graduated from the University in Harare, Zimbabwe, and would like to get involved with Sattelite Bible College. We experienced the anointing of God upon our services

and saw people getting saved, sick being healed, some being baptised in the Holy Spirit and at least two were set free from demonic power. GOD IS GOOD!

We were also able to donate six bicycles with all the extras to six pastors. It was a gift from *Wheels for God's Word & Word on Wheels*. They have given more than two and a half thousand bicycles to pastors in the Southern, Eastern, Western and Central regions of Africa.
