Gods Word, Word on Wheels and Multi Ministries, to be an instrument of His grace and favour to bless these servants of God with wheels, literature and training.

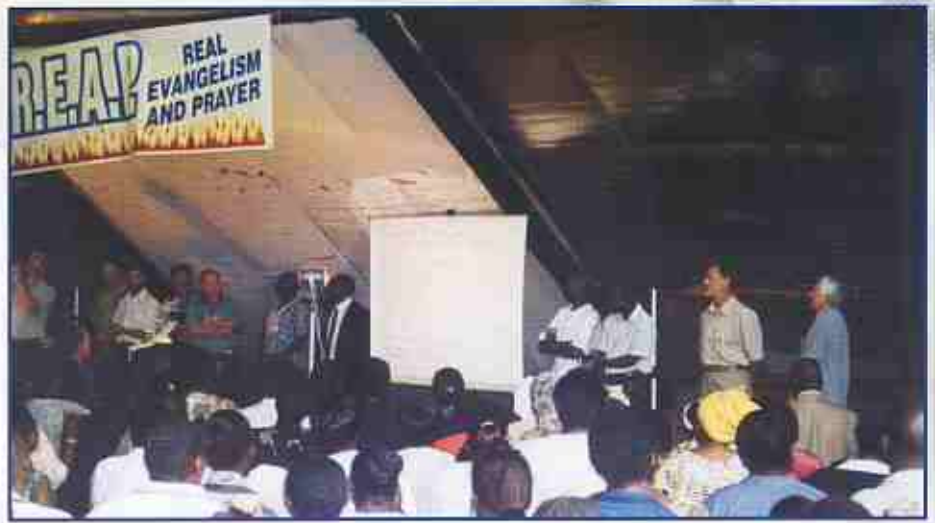

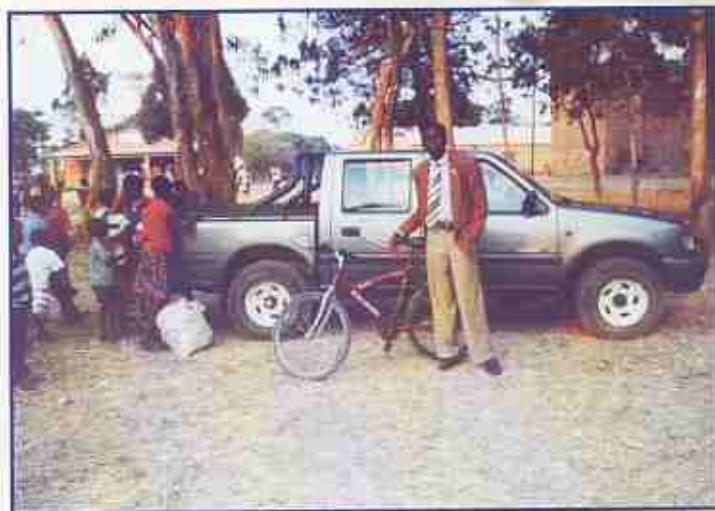


ZIMBABWE

Right: Noël Pickett looks at one of the evangelists who prays for the people, who committed their lives to Christ.

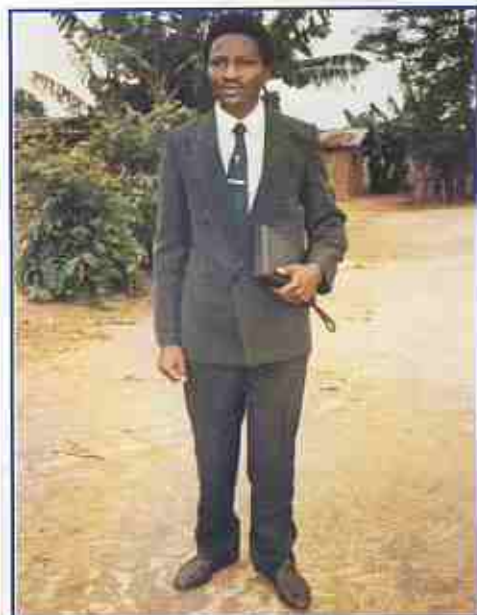


REPORT BACK FROM CONGO

Growing in Grace - church growth in Mpumalanga

We received a very touching letter about the tremendous growth of churches in Mpumalanga.

Annelie Nel (Pastor - Fellowship of Harvesters) wrote the following to *Word on Wheels* offices:

"Even after combining some of the churches to cope with the sudden growth in churches, the amount increased from just a few to about 110 (one hundred and ten) churches. It occupies the area between Komatipoort in the east, Swaziland in the south, Graskop in the north and Badplaas in the west.

We want to thank you for continuous support through the *Growing in Grace* discipleship course. It is a great help to keep the training and teaching in these churches pure with the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Many lives have been changed and God alone is honoured. The churches start as small home churches, but soon become so big that they have to gather outside under the trees or shelters. I am of the

honest opinion that the Holy Spirit has started a revival in this community of South Africa. For the past seven years we have been in prayer and ministry for this area, trusting that God will change the spiritual darkness of the area previously known as Kangwane, into a point from where the Holy Spirit fire will move into the rest of the country.

These evangelists travel long distances and even by night. It is very time consuming and unsafe to do on foot. The fast growth of the church has increased the need for transportation."

Wheels for God's Word and *Word on Wheels* helped Annelie with the necessary "tools" i.e. Bicycles and Heart of Man charts. Annelie wrote: "God is demonstrating His love amongst these very poor people of South Africa in a special way as the people move in thankfulness and prayer, which results in many miracles and wonders."

It's truly a fact that God is a God that will never change nor forget His promises. For we can be sure that eventually the impact that He made in the lives of the people from this community in Mpumalanga, will be carried throughout our country.
